### Galicia Jewish Museum

The Galicia Jewish Museum in Krakow will mark the 2nd September with free entrance to the Museum

The permanent exhibition, **Traces of Memory**, is a contemporary look at the Jewish past in Poland. The exhibition features the work of photographer Chris Schwarz, with texts by Prof. Jonathan Webber (UNESCO Chair of Jewish and Interfaith Studies, University of Birmingham, UK). Over a period of twelve years, they travelled together town by town and village by village, gathering material that offers a completely new way of looking at the Jewish past that was destroyed in Poland. The exhibition pieces together a picture of the relics of Jewish life and culture in Polish Galicia that can still be seen today, interpreting these traces in a manner which is informative, accessible, and thought-provoking.

The exhibition is divided into five sections, corresponding to the different ways in which the subject can be approached: Section 1 is entitled Jewish Life in Ruins, with all the sadness of confronting the past. Section 2, Jewish Culture as it once Was, displays remaining signs of the original culture. Section 3, Sites of Massacre and Destruction shows the horror of the Holocaust. Section 4, How the Past is Being Remembered recognises the efforts to preserve the traces of memory, and Section 5, People Making Memory Today, shows people involved in recreating the memory of the Jewish past in Poland today.

The Galicia Jewish Museum also features visiting and temporary exhibitions.

### Fighting for Dignity: Jewish Resistance in Kraków

An innovative and challenging new exhibition created by the Galicia Jewish Museum, curated by Jakub Nowakowski. A stimulating and poignant portrayal of Jewish resistance during the Holocaust, both armed and non-armed, confronting head-on the cultural, religious, and moral dilemmas faced by the Jewish community between 1939 and 1945.

**Letters to Sala: A Young Woman's Life in Nazi Labour Camps**

The first European showing of Letters to Sala: A Young Woman's Life in Nazi Labour Camps, a compelling collection of rare Holocaust-era letters and photographs from the archives of the New York Public Library, all saved at great personal risk by Sala Garncarz during her imprisonment from 1940 until her liberation in 1945. The collection provides a remarkable first-hand view of the human drama that unfolded among Jewish victims forced to work in Nazi labour camps. Curated by Jill Vexler.
